Mr. Thomas and Ms. Bryan brought the Council up to date on negotiations for the City's solid waste and recyclables collection services. See handout attached. One year remains on the current contract with Waste Management (ARS). Waste Management confirms a price structure of \$9.65/HHD for residential services.

Following discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Kirkman, and unanimously carried, to instruct Mr. Thomas to negotiate further by informing Waste Management that \$9/HHD is reasonable, and leaving them in the wings, talk with BFI.
