Lee County Economic Development Director Bob Heuts was present.

Mayor Hester called the closed session to order.

Lee County Economic Development Director Bob Heuts informed Council that Frontier Jet Spinning will be completing its expansion project. The value of the land, building and equipment will be \$47,680,573. Frontier is asking for the current agreement to be amended for incentives over the next five years.

Imperial Freezer Services, LLC will be constructing a manufacturing plant at an estimated cost of \$3,000,000. Agreement for incentives will be for a three-year period. A public hearing will be held on July 18 for this agreement.
