


All Aboard for Sanford!








#1 • Take a ride in a buggy and search in the courtyard of Café 121.

Draw a picture of one of the cows in the mural.






#3 • Engineer Cole says to check the public parking lot on S. Steele Street for a runaway train. Draw a picture of a runaway train.




#4 • Conductor Stanley wants to take a train trip to an island on Wicker Street. Draw a picture of a train on an island.

#6 • Look for the historical entrance to the Sanford Business College. Draw a picture of your school.






#7 • When your feet get tired, sit a spell at Charlie Watson Lane. Draw a picture of a newspaper.




#8 • Number 12 is chugging along in front of the historical site of the SanLee Theater. Draw a picture of the Temple Theatre.
