

What is the Sanford Youth Academy?

The Sanford Youth Academy is a week-long summer program for rising seventh graders who attend Lee County Schools.

The Academy will offer insight into the City's first response departments, including the Sanford Police Department and Sanford Fire Department.

Participants will also visit points of interest in Sanford to engage in positive learning experiences.

The camp is open to 15 participants. Lunch and a snack will be provided.

What can youth expect from the Youth Academy?

Youth who participate in the program will have the chance to:

- Explore the City's first response departments
- Participate in hands-on activities each day
- Practice conflict resolution
- Develop leadership skills.

Statement of Purpose

The goal for the Youth Academy is to strengthen relationships between local youth and first responders, while also exposing youth to potential career paths.

Who will work with Youth Academy participants?

Each day, youth will interact directly with law enforcement, firefighters, and other professionals.

Instructors are experienced police officers, fire fighters, Sheriff's deputies, and instructors who provide vital services to residents in Sanford and/or Lee County.

How are participants chosen?

The selection process attempts to reflect a balanced representation of the various races and cultural groups with Sanford. This includes males and females, as well as individuals from various ethnic, civic, and cultural groups. Selected participants will be notified by phone and email.

How much does Youth Academy cost?

This camp is being offered at no cost to participants. Transportation to/from the program each day is not provided.

Submit the application form to the school guidance counselor or return it to the City of Sanford by June 15, 2019.
