Notice is hereby given that the Historic Preservation Commission will hold a public hearing on Monday, March 21, 2016, in the West End Conference Room of the Sanford Municipal Building, 225 East Weatherspoon Street, Sanford, NC 27330. The hearing will begin at 7:00 p.m. or as soon as deemed practical by the Chairman of the Historic Preservation Commission. The Historic Preservation Commission will consider:

- **COA-16-04** - Application by Stephen Mohr, property owner of 219 N. Gulf Street, who wishes to remove three trees (two Loblolly pines and 1 Tulip poplar, which were deemed to be in good condition in 2008) located in the north side yard between 219 N. Gulf and 221 N. Gulf Street in excess of eight (8) inches in caliper.
- **COA-16-05** - Application by Jackie Ledbetter, property owner of 504 Summitt Drive, who wishes to remove one tree (one Post oak which was deemed to be in fair condition in 2008) in excess of 8 inches in caliper located in the front yard.
