

**City of Sanford Historic Preservation Commission
Public Hearing Notice**

Notice is hereby given that the Historic Preservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Monday, September 28, 2020**, the hearing will be held in **Council Chambers in City Hall located at 225 E. Weatherspoon Street Sanford, NC 27330**. The hearing will begin at **7:00 p.m.** or as soon as deemed practical by the Chairman of the Historic Preservation Commission. The Historic Preservation Commission will consider:

COA-20-35 - Application by the City of Sanford, who wishes to install 4 concrete pillars 2 to 3 feet tall in Charlie Watson Lane. Two will be at each end of the Lane. The pillars will be tiled mosaics which an arch will be mounted at a later date.

COA-20-36 – Application by Nathaniel Dobbs, property owner of 311 Green Street, who wishes to remove 5 trees located in the rear yard. Two trees should be planted to maintain the tree canopy in the Historic District.

COA-20-37- Application by Greg and Jocelyn Stoch, property owners of 220 N. Gulf Street, who wish to install a new driveway and driveway cut, pave said driveway and remove existing macadam.

COA-20-38 – Application by Lee County, property owner of 408 Summitt Drive who wishes to remove five trees.
